RNC Adopts Three New Resolutions Aimed at Promoting Conservatism Party Platform Conservative Caucus

With help from the Republican National Conservative Caucus (RNCC), the Republican National Committee (RNC) adopted three new measures last month aimed at advancing the Republican Party for the 2010 mid-term elections and beyond.

Each resolution helps clearly identify the Republican party's platform on critical issues facing our nation and each offers a real Republican solution to some of the nation's most pressing issues. The resolutions are:

“Obamacare: Marching Further Towards

Socialism,” which establishes Republican solutions to the health care crisis, including tort reform, elimination of government mandates for non-essential care and tax incentives.
